



Arena & Warm up Guide Lines

ARENA TRAFFIC:

- ❖ Circles must be facing the judge's chairs, on the left wall of the arena. Left circles are on the left side of the arena. Right circles are on the far end of the arena.
- ❖ Circles have priority (consider it like a highway!). No stopping at center to give room to the horses still loping on circles. Stop on the inside of the circle.
- ❖ Spins are done in the middle of each circle.
- ❖ Please don't go around the perimeter of the arena. Stay on circles, or up and down the arena at fencing time.
- ❖ In each warm up, the first 10-15 minutes of the warm up is for circles. The second 10-15 minutes are for fencing (20 to 30 minutes warm-up depending of the classes).
- ❖ No horses are to be tied in the arena and/or left unattended at any time.
- ❖ No spinning or schooling in the staging area

No abuse will be tolerated towards any members, committee members, judges or animals during any Reining Alberta shows.
